

Illinois bill would allow more deer-hunting firearms, cap rounds at three

New regulations could be in store for deer hunters if a new bill passes limiting rifle rounds.

Deer hunters would have more firearm options under a Republican-backed bill in the Illinois House.

If passed, [Illinois House Bill 4504](#) would amend the Illinois Wildlife Code and remove the limitation allowing only single-shot firearms or firearms permanently modified to be single-shot. Instead, the code would allow hunters to use handguns and rifles limited to three rounds or fewer.

The proposal comes from Republican Rep. Wayne A. Rosenthal, who represents the 108th District in central Illinois.

Under the proposal, hunters would be limited to centerfire revolvers, centerfire handguns and centerfire rifles. If a centerfire firearm is capable of holding more than three rounds, it would need to be fitted with a one-piece plug that is irremovable without dismantling it.

Previously in Illinois, it was [illegal to hunt deer with a rifle](#). Instead, hunters were limited to handguns, shotguns and muzzleloaders. That changed with the Democrat-backed House Bill 4386, which was passed and signed into law by Gov. J.B. Pritzker and took effect in January 2023. The law allowed the use of centerfire single-shot rifles of .30 caliber or larger. When that law passed, it was noted in the [Journal-Courier that the law](#) "effectively eliminates Illinois as an island where rifle hunting for deer was illegal."

According to HB 4505, the Illinois Department of Natural Resources would be responsible for writing and adopting the new rules.

Godfrey Lake Rules

Only Club members and their guests are permitted on the club grounds. Guests must be accompanied by a Club Member or spouse of a Club Member.

Fishing in the club lake is reserved for members and their immediate family under twenty-one years of age. An out-of-town house guest will be permitted to fish, and only when accompanied by a Club member or spouse of a Club member.

Children under the age of sixteen years must be accompanied by a member or spouse of a Club member. All Junior members must be accompanied after dark.

Junior members under the age of sixteen can bring guests to the lake.

No alcohol may be consumed or possessed by minors.

Fires must be in designated fireplaces or portable grills. Clean up your litter.

Organized games or groups of 10 or more should check in with the Manager.

All overnight campers shall register with the Club manager.

Removal or damage to trees or shrubbery is not permitted. Do not litter.

All persons fishing the lake must comply with all State fishing regulations. Rod and reel or pole and line fishing only will be permitted.

Members may put boats on the lake. Electric trolling motors only, no gasoline motors.

Any boat being used on the lake must have Coast Guard-approved life jackets or cushions for each occupant. No person under the age of sixteen will be allowed in a boat unless accompanied by an adult Member.

No wading, swimming, or ice-skating permitted.

No hunting allowed on Godfrey Club grounds. Archery deer hunting is allowed from October 1st through January 15th. Rules do apply, and are being updated.

Members and Junior Members sixteen years and over are permitted to work or train their dogs in the small or large lake.

Any person violating the foregoing rules or engaging in any illegal conduct on the Club Lakes or grounds shall be subject to review by the Board of Directors and subject to dismissal. Members are responsible for their guests.

Membership Meetings are on the 3rd
Tuesday of each month at 6:30 PM.

All members are encouraged to
attend. Associate members do not
have voting privileges but may be
heard and voice their opinions.
These meetings are essential in
keeping the club operational.




