Bylaws you should know.

Article VII OFFICERS

Section 1. The officers of the club shall be a President, Vice President, Corresponding Secretary, Financial Secretary, Treasurer and Membership Secretary.

Section 2. The President shall preside at all regular and special meetings of the Club and at the meeting of the Board of Directors. He shall not vote except in the case of a tie, and he shall perform such other duties as are the usual incident of his office as President.

Section 3. The Vice President shall assume all the duties of the President in his absence or disability.

Section 4. The Corresponding Secretary shall keep a record of the proceedings of all meetings of the Club and of the meetings of the Board of Directors, and all activities of the Club. He shall also keep and preserve the official books, records and other papers of the Club, and shall sign and attest all such papers as are incidental to his office. General correspondence to the Club shall be addressed to the Secretary, presented by him to the proper committee, and kept as a record in his files. All correspondence by the Club or by an officer thereof shall be filed with the Secretary.

Section 5. The Treasurer shall be responsible for the safekeeping and disbursement of all funds belonging to the Club. All Club funds shall be deposited in such bank as the official depository designated by resolution of the Board of Directors. All disbursements shall be made by check drawn on such depository, signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by an officer or Director. The Treasurer shall be bonded at all times by a corporate surety in sufficient sum as designated by the Board of Directors. All disbursements shall have prior approval of the Finance Committee or the Board of Directors, except fixed periodic salary, utility bills, and other regular periodic payments. The Treasurer shall deposit in a special account at the disposal of the General Manager such sums as may be designated by the Board of Directors for payment of current operating expenses, which disbursements shall be reported monthly to the Board of Directors and the said fund replenished after audit of said disbursements.

Section 6. The Financial Secretary shall be responsible for the receipt and deposit of all income amounts, gifts or other funds coming in to the accounts of the Club. He shall see that all such accounts are collected and audited monthly and deposited in the official depository designated by the Board of Directors. The Financial Secretary shall be bonded as the Board of Directors designate.

Section 7. The membership Secretary shall receive applications and issue membership cards to all approved new and renewal members upon receipt of proper monies. These monies shall be deposited with the Financial Secretary. A complete and accurate record of members in good standing shall be kept up to date at all times. Notice of dues payable shall be sent to all members not later than December 15. The Membership Secretary shall be bonded as the Board of Directors designate.

Section 8. In the event any officer or director shall fail to attend any two regular meetings in succession, without excuse approved by the President, or shall otherwise fail to fulfill the duties of his office, then by two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors or by a majority vote of members, such office shall be declared vacant and shall be filled for the unexpired term as herein otherwise provided.

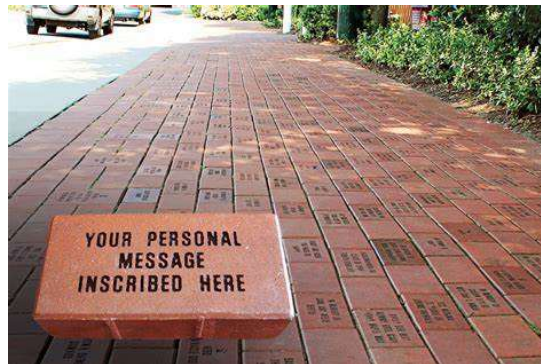

Pleasant Hill



Pleasant Hill Facility

The Club's Pleasant Hill facility is located approximately 5 miles south of Pleasant Hill, Il. on 700 acres of timber and farmland with a 3-story clubhouse. There are 60 permanent camper sites and 3 temporary camper sites, all surrounded by woods on the Mississippi River below the Clarksville Dam. The boat ramp provides easy access to the river for eligible members. There are duck blinds, and deer stands available for members that are eligible to use them. (See the membership rules and requirements for more information). The clubhouse has restrooms, showers, bedrooms, refrigerators, and a fully stocked kitchen with pots, pans, and silverware. Rates for using the cots in the clubhouse are posted by the sign-in register in the basement. Camping is permitted year-round. NOTE: Temporary camper sites and cots in the clubhouse are available on a first-come, first-served basis. You must be a Waterfowl or Regular Member to have a permanent camper site.

- The dumpster is for garbage not large items as in couches, chairs etc.
- The electric bills are excessive, please turn off what's not needed when you are not there. There are talks of power meters being installed at each camper and members paying the electric fees for their own use.
 - Water issues have been fixed, please remember this is well water and not potable.
- When the clubhouse is not in use, please turn off lights and keep doors closed. Take your belongings out of the freezers and refrigerators before you leave. Leave it clean for the next person.

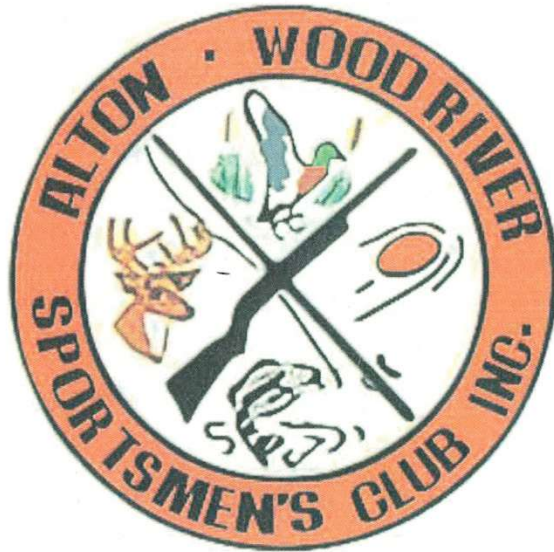
The lounge is being overhauled, thanks to members donations. If you would like to donate please contact any board member. We have a long way to go.

Godfrey Lake

1. Only Club members and their guests are permitted on the club grounds. Guests must be accompanied by a Club Member or spouse of a Club Member.
2. Fishing in the club lake is reserved for members and their immediate family under twenty-one years of age. An out-of-town house guest will be permitted to fish, and only when accompanied by a Club member or spouse of a Club member.
3. Children under the age of sixteen years must be accompanied by a member or spouse of a Club member. All Junior members must be accompanied after dark.
4. Junior members under the age of sixteen can bring guests to the lake.
5. No alcohol may be consumed or possessed by minors.
6. Fires must be in designated fireplaces or portable grills. Clean up your litter.
7. Organized games or groups of 10 or more should check in with the Manager.
8. All overnight campers shall register with the Club manager.
9. Removal or damage to trees or shrubbery is not permitted. Do not litter.
10. All persons fishing the lake must comply with all State fishing regulations. Rod and reel or pole and line fishing only will be permitted.
11. Members may put boats on the lake. Electric trolling motors only, no gasoline motors.
12. Any boat being used on the lake must have Coast Guard-approved life jackets or cushions for each occupant. No person under the age of sixteen will be allowed in a boat unless accompanied by an adult Member.
13. No wading, swimming, or ice-skating permitted.
14. No hunting allowed on Godfrey Club grounds. Archery deer hunting is allowed from October 1st through January 15th. Rules do apply, and are being updated.
15. Members and Junior Members sixteen years and over are permitted to work or train their dogs in the small or large lake.
16. Any person violating the foregoing rules or engaging in any illegal conduct on the Club Lakes or grounds shall be subject to review by the Board of Directors and subject to dismissal. Members are responsible for their guests.
17. The front lake is for youth only and is catch and release. Any adult members caught fishing the front lake may have their membership revoked or suspended.

Membership Meetings are on the 3rd Tuesday of each month at 6:30 PM. All members are encouraged to attend. Associate members do not have voting privileges but may be heard and voice their opinions. These meetings are essential in keeping the club operational.

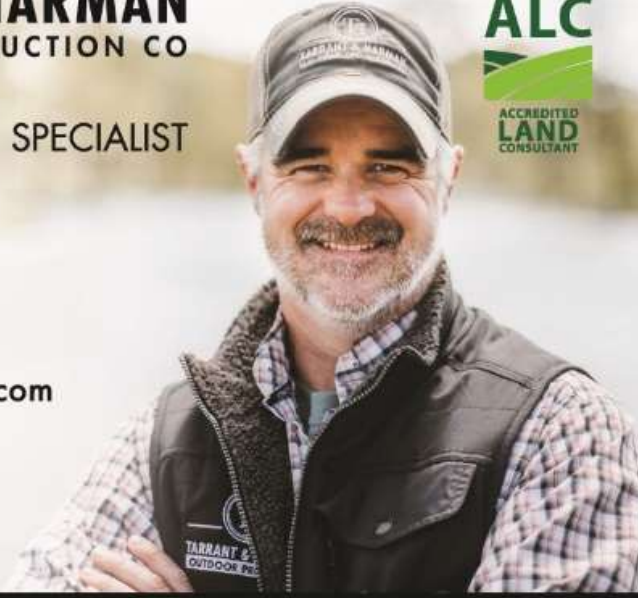
